MASTER PLUMBERS' MEETING.

A meeting of the master plumbers of the city was held last evening in the Builders' Exchange, Courier Building. There was a good attendance of the craft present. The meeting had been called together for the purpose of considering the question of the master plumbers of Brisbane being represented at a conference of the master plumbers of Australia, which is to be held in Melbourne in July next. After a general discussion as to the advisableness of forming an association in Brisbane, it was resolved that such an association be formed. and these present handed in their names as members. A provisional committee was aptointed to draft rules for presentation to a future meeting, and also for the purpose of seeking the co-operation of the whole of the master plumbers of the city in the movement.
